Entry level post at London Living Wage. We are hiring both part-time and full-time project officers.

ATD Fourth World works in partnership with people affected by long-term poverty to develop their potential and enable them to participate fully in the life of their communities and society at large.

Our *Giving Poverty a Voice (GPAV)* - Policy, Participation and Training Programme empowers people with experience of poverty to engage in public debate. By providing people with the confidence and skills with which to campaign and speak out, the programme builds individual and collective activism. Together, our lived-experience activists work with our allies in the anti-poverty, human rights and social work fields to influence research, policy and practice.

The **Project Officer** is a member of the **GPAV operations team** and should work to further the objectives of ATD Fourth World in accordance with the organisation's values and ethos. The Project Officer is based at ATD Fourth World's main office at 48 Addington Square, London, SE5 7LB.

Role & responsibilities

The main duties of the Project Officer include:

- Participation in regular GPAV operation team meetings
- Assisting with the organising, preparing and co-facilitating of GPAV programme activities (e.g. workshops, discussion groups, training)
- Contacting lived-experience activists to invite them to GPAV activities and support their logistical arrangements
- Providing bespoke one-to-one support, follow-up and accompaniment for lived-experience activists
- Supporting lived-experience activists to prepare responses to policy consultations, public speaking engagements, external meetings etc.
- Writing meeting minutes, summary reports and articles
- Supporting communications, namely ATD's newsletter, social media channels and website
- Collecting monitoring and evaluation information for the GPAV
 programme
- Networking and liaising with existing and potential GPAV partner organisations
